The NSW Volleyball Referees Association (NSWVRA) provides education and support services to State Volleyball NSW and members of the broader Volleyball community.

We understand that many referees incur large out of pocket costs to travel to and from local, state, national and international matches held in Australia, with majority of travel and accommodation costs incurred at the personal cost of the travelling official.

As part of NSWVRA's commitment to support and encourage pathways for referees who wish to use their skills at higher levels of volleyball refereeing, NSWVRA is calling for nominations for the 2018 NSWVRA Officiating Scholarship.

In 2018, **one** scholarship for a referee residing in NSW will be awarded to assist with travel or accommodation costs in order to allow for the recipient to actively pursue refereeing opportunities without financial burden.

The scholarship will be valid from 1 January 2018 – 31 December 2018, and will cover referees travel, accommodation charges of up to **\$500** during the course of officiating duties in Australia.

The successful scholarship holder will also be provided with a mentor from NSW to support their development towards becoming a high level referee.

Requirement

- Current accredited referee and member of NSWVRA
- Demonstrate active refereeing involvement with local, state or national volleyball competition
- Outline ways this scholarship would assist your personal circumstances
